

COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL FOR SWIMMING POOLS IN COMMUNITIES OF OWNERS (PHASE 2)

Order SND/414/2020 published in the Official State Gazette [BOE] on 16 May 2020, sets out the conditions in which swimming pools can open in communities of owners during phase 2 of the plan for the transition to new normality.





Measures to be adopted



Cleaning and disinfecting three times a day all points of most frequent contact, such as taps or railings. For this, a solution of bleach or other disinfectants authorised

by the Health Department will be used in a dilution of 1:50

Disinfection of pool water by

physical and chemical filtration, and routine checks

Establishing a control system of prior appointments to allow a **maximum capacity of 30%** of users, and provided that a minimum safety distance of 2 metres can be guaranteed between users in the rest and leisure areas

Limitations to be observed



People in home confinement due to being diagnosed with COVID-19, having symptoms compatible with this virus or who show no symptoms but are in quarantine due to having been in contact with someone who has been diagnosed or displays those symptoms, may not access the pool area

Changing rooms and fountains may not be used. Bathrooms must be entered one person at a time

Whilst in the pool area, **there must be no sharing of items** with users not forming part of the family unit or living in the same property, and towels, creams or personal clothing and bags must be kept at the established interpersonal distance

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
